Dear Parents/Carers,

My name is Rachel Barton and I am the Headteacher at Littleton C of E Infant School.

In September 2016 we opened a teacher led onsite nursery at our school called 'Littleton Explorers'. Our vision was to create an 'Early Years Centre of Excellence' that would enable children in our local community to access high quality provision. Extensive educational research has shown that long term positive outcomes for children are significantly increased when they have access to high quality nursery provision. Our aim is to prepare each child for school through a play based fun and exciting environment. We are also fortunate to be able to offer Forest School provision as part of our nursery curriculum. Forest School focuses on building the children's skills in resilience and growth mindset that will prepare them for lifelong learning.

As leaders of London Diocesan and C of E schools which are geographically close (our school is less than a 10 minute drive from Ashford C of E and directly opposite Shepperton Studios), Mrs Dyer and I work closely together and support the mutual development of both our schools. The nursery team at Littleton would work closely with Ashford C of E to ensure a strong and smooth transition from our nursery into Ashford C of E, which would be of great benefit to each child and their family. We offer places to 3 and 4 year olds, rising threes and FEET funded 2 year olds.

We have had excellent parent feedback about Littleton Explorers and 100% of our parents would recommend the nursery to other families.
