English

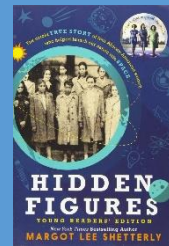
Maths

In maths we are learning about multiplication and division. We will be learning to:

- Multiply up to a 4-digit number by a 2-digit number
- Short division
- Division with remainders
- Efficient division
- Solve problems using multiplication and division



This half-term we are reading



In English the children will continue reading Hidden Figures by Margot Lee Shetterly in which children learn about the achievements and determination of four iconic women at key moments in American and world history.

This provides the inspiring context for children to write for a range of purposes and for different formal and informal contexts.

These will include: Non-chronological reports, formal persuasive letters, informal letters, diary entries, character descriptions, opinion pieces and a memoir of one of the women.

RE

Our big question in RE this half term is:

How did the first five Sikh Gurus shape Sikhism?

Science

In science we are learning about how and why we use different materials in everyday life.

This unit will include learning about electrical and thermal conductors and insulators and magnetism.

Geography

Our big question this term is:

Why do earthquakes and volcanoes happen?

We will be learning about the structure of the Earth, what happens when the Earth's plates meet, what is inside a volcano and facts about famous earthquakes and volcanoes.
