After that, we will be reading *The Tempest* by William Shakespeare. We will be exploring playscripts, including setting descriptions, dialogue, stage directions and character descriptions and comparisons. The children will eventually write their own playscript based on the story.


Maths

In Maths we are studying units on decimals & percentages and area & perimeter.

This will include learning about:

- Tenths, hundredths and thousandths
- Ordering decimals
- Equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages
- Perimeter and area of rectangles
- Area of compound shapes

Art

In art we will be looking at a range of portraits and creating a mixed media self-portrait

Music

The children will be studying pulse, rhythm and pitch within different pieces of music. There will also be singing and composing opportunities.

RE

Our big question in RE this half term is:

What happens in churches during Lent, Holy Week and Easter Sunday?

Science

In Science we are continuing to learn about different materials.

This half-term will include reversible and irreversible changes, dissolving and looking at methods for separating materials.

History

Our big question this term is: Why are the Tudors significant in British history?

We will be learning about how the Tudors came to power in the Battle of Bosworth, the infamous Henry VIII and the impact he had on religion, and why Elizabeth I was such a significant monarch.

Computing

In computing the children will continue creating and editing their own videos.

PE
