Maths

In maths we are learning about shape, position and direction and decimals.

This will include learning about:

- Measuring and calculating angles.
- Regular and irregular polygons.
- 3D shapes.
- Reading and plotting coordinates.
- Translation, reflection and symmetry.
- Adding and subtracting decimals.

We will be finishing reading The Tempest by William Shakespeare and the children will be writing their own playscript based on the storv.

We will then be reading Kaspar the Prince of Cats by Micheal Morpurgo. The children will explore a range of fiction and non-fiction writing opportunities including letter writing, narrative writing an alternative ending, newspaper articles, recounts and researching The Titanic and its voyage.

Our big question in RE this half term is:

Science
