Maths


In maths, we will complete our learning about statistics by creating our own pie charts.

We are also preparing for secondary school by learning to use a calculator.

We will also be consolidating all our primary school maths learning through problem solving activities.

This half-term

we are reading:



In English, we will finish studying Romeo & Juliet by writing a descriptive narrative about the duel scene between the Montagues and Capulets.

The children will also write a balanced argument about mobile phones for under 16s and a letter recounting their trip to PGL.

Summer 2

RE

This half-term the children will debate the topic 'Rules and Responsibilities: Who Decides?'

They will consider why we have rules, look at guidelines in the Islamic faith and develop their own creeds for life.

Science

We will build on our learning from last half term with our big question 'How can we stay healthy?'

The children will investigate the impact of exercise, diet, drugs and lifestyle on the human body. This will develop their understanding of how to live a healthy lifestyle.

History

In our final history unit, we will learn about the ancient Maya and answer the question 'How did the Maya civilisation contrast with British history and what were the achievements of the earliest civilisations?'
