

Literacy-

Read individual letters by saying the sounds for them. Blend sounds into words, so that they can read short words made up of known letter—sound correspondences.

<u>Understanding of the World-</u>

Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways.

Describe what they see, hear and feel whilst outside.

Expressive Art & Design-

Explore and engage in music making and dance, performing solo or in groups.
