- Bonus raffle in September for children who show they have completed the challenge.



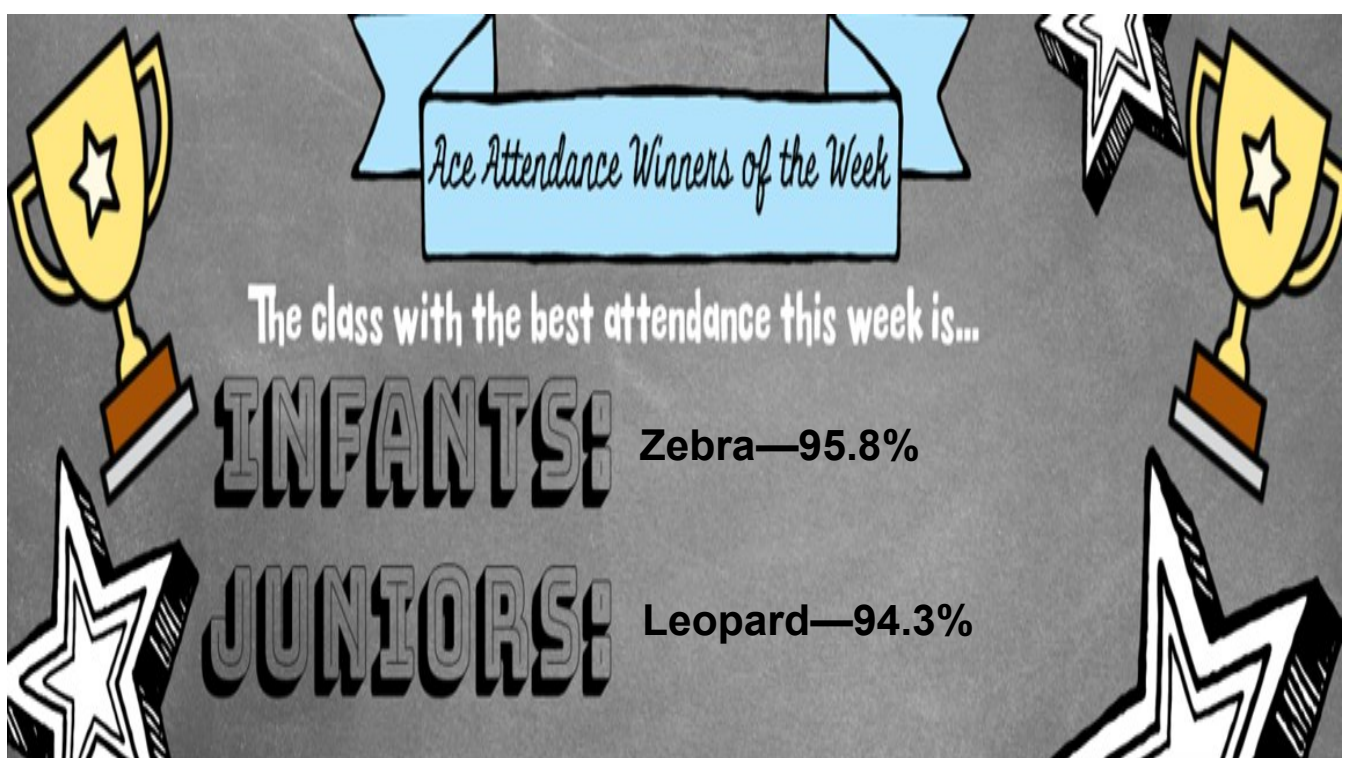
