This links to our school vision as we celebrate "our God-given individuality, achievements and talents and we aspire, with God's help to become the best that we can be."

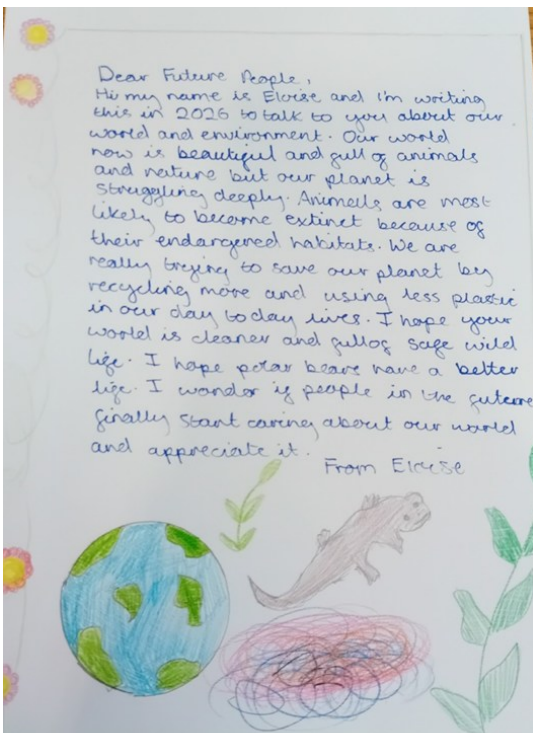
We looked at Psalm 148 which praises God for all that he has created. The children were encouraged to reflect on what they were thankful for and they gave

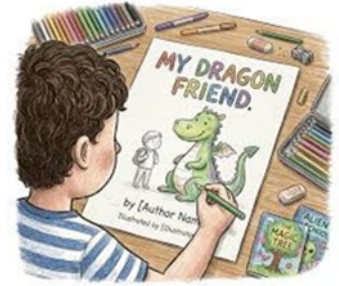

More information on this will be shared nearer to moving up day.

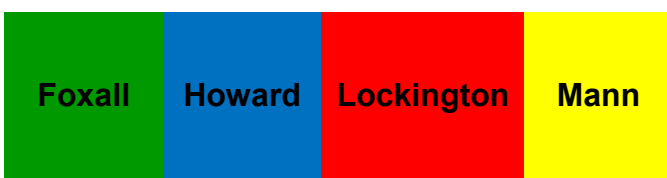
Sports Day
