### Penalty Notice for Unauthorised Absence

JUST to remind parents/carers that if they take their children out of school without authority for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive) in a 10 week period, they will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Currently the amount payable under a penalty notice is £160.00 per parent/carer per child if paid which reduces to £80 if paid within 21 days. If a further 5 days absence occurs parents will be liable for a second penalty notice of £160 per parent per child with no reduction. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local Authority will consider a prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child so a family of two parents and two children will receive 4 penalty notices. Further absence could also result in prosecution.

We understand that occasionally you may forget to do this. If you have forgotten please contact the school office who are able to order for you.


This week our kitchen had to provide more than 20 extra lunches on one day due to orders not being placed

Tiger Class have all been busy recently. Rosie getting her




level one Swimming and Bella-Rose and Scarlett winning medals at holiday club.
