All lunch balances should be zero by the end of term. We will be unable to process any refunds after this time.

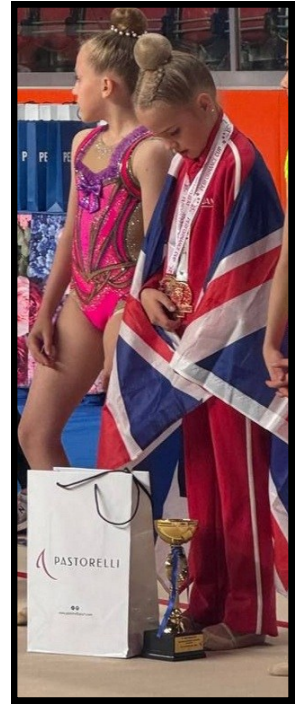


ACE Achievers

Well done Stephanie!

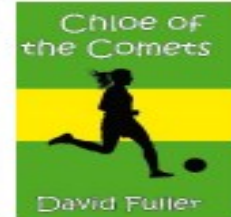
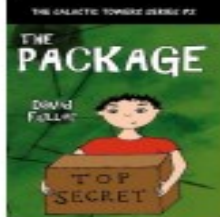
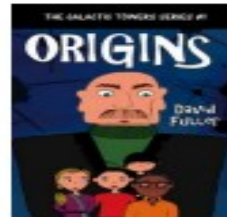
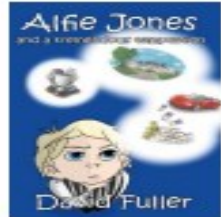
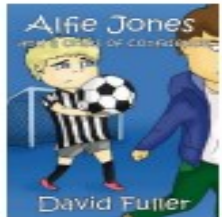
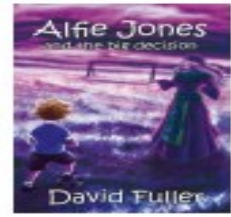
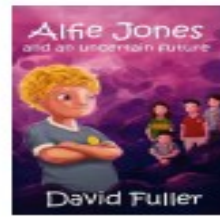
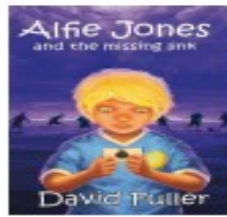
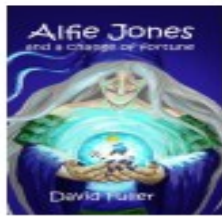


Vidit from Lemur Class is learning Martial Arts with Shentie (Martial Arts Academy) a well known name for Defence skills / Skill for life.

David will also be selling and signing copies of his book(s) at the reduced price of £4.50 (usually £5) to any children who would like a copy.



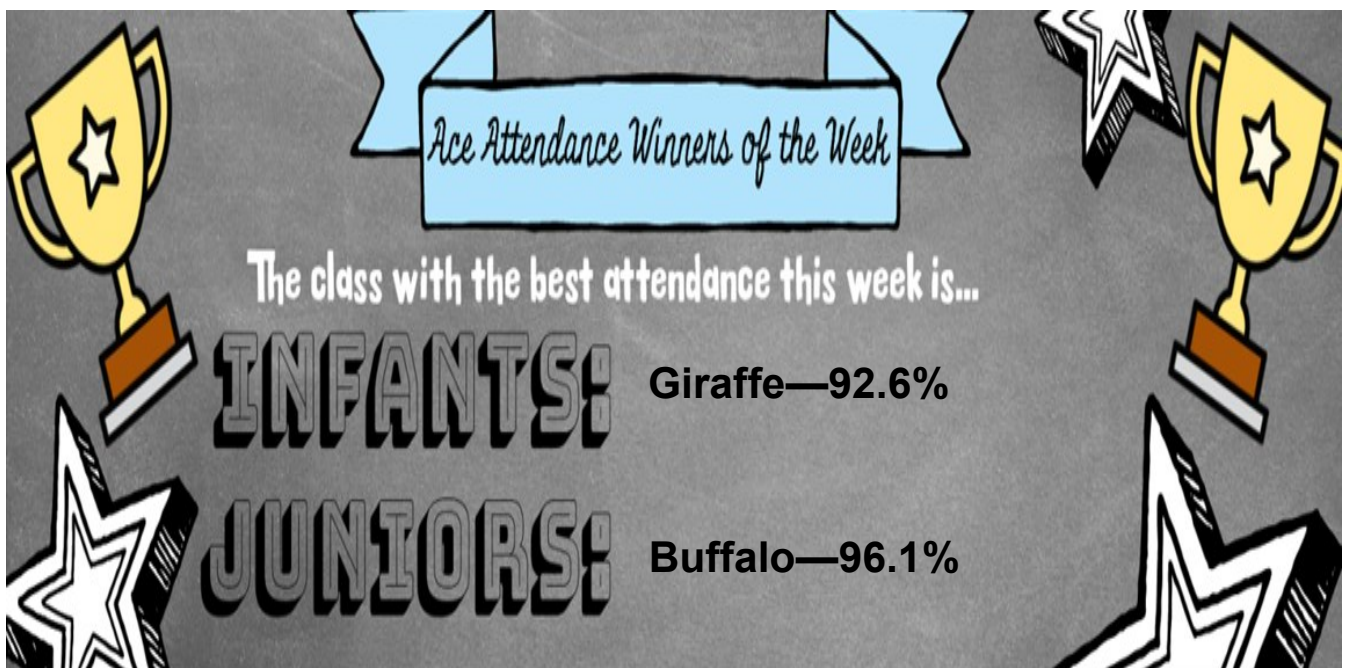
