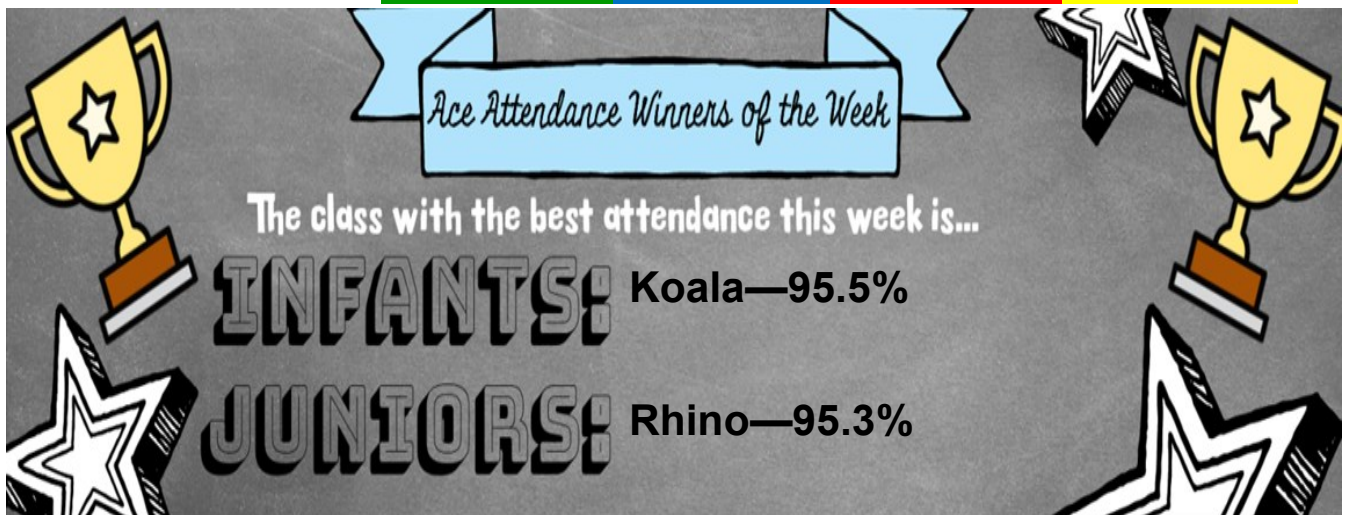
# ACE Achievers
