## Changes to Attendance Penalties

AS you may be aware, changes to the way the local authority issues penalty notices for school absence is changing from September.

Penalty notices will be issued if a child has 10 periods of unauthorised absence which is equivalent to 5 days. The absence does not have to be consecutive just in a 10 week period.

The charge for a first penalty is £160 per parent, per child with a reduction if you pay in 21 days. If you incur a second penalty the charge is £160 with no reduction. A third penalty in a rolling 3 year period will mean that Surrey will consider a prosecution. There will be further notices in future editions of Highlights.

## School lunch from September

THE cost of a school lunch for Years 3-6 will be £2.80 per day from September.

If you qualify for free school meals please ensure your child takes the meal. If you send your child with a packed lunch on a day you have ordered a meal then the school will have to meet the cost and it is a waste of food.

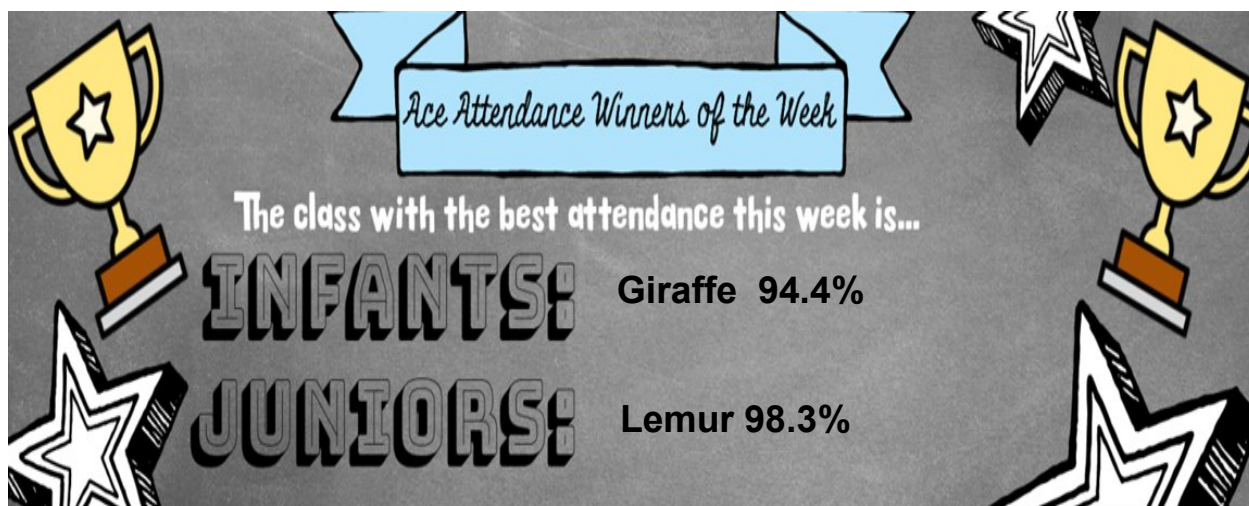
## It's Coming Home!
