Who was Richard III?

- The people of York and Lancaster had been fighting for the crown of England for over 100 years.
- Richard of York became King of England in 1482.



Who was Henry VII?

- Henry was the great-grandson of the Duke of Lancaster.
- He was banished to France as Richard feared he might try to take the throne.
- In 1485 Henry gathered some support in England and landed in Wales with his supporters.



The Battle



- Richard gathered his 6,000 supporters and marched towards Ambien Hill.
- He hoped to meet and defeat Henry before he brought his army to London.
- Henry approached with 2,000 men.
- Richard waited with his men for four days.



How did Henry win?

- Gradually Richard's men began to lose hope and began to leave.
- It is thought that the Duke of Northumberland betrayed Richard and joined Henry.
- Richard left his high point and was slain.
- Henry was crowned Henry VII of England.
