

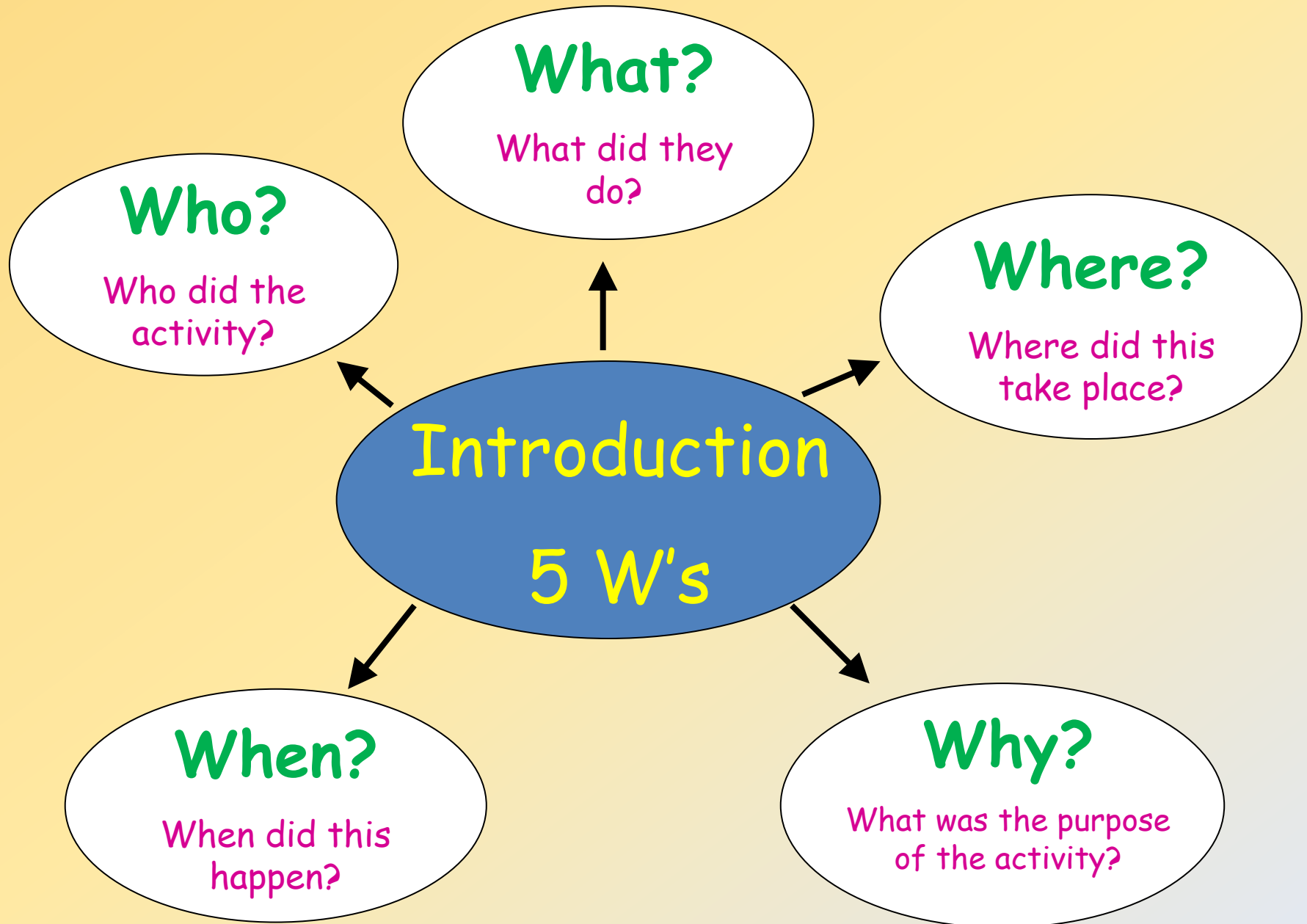

INTRODUCTION – 1 paragraph

Short summary of what you're writing about.

MAIN TEXT – 1/2 paragraphs

Events in chronological order in more detail.

CONCLUSION – 1 paragraph

How your day ended and how you felt about it
