Learning Focus:	This half-term, the children are learning why WW2 is an important part of British history. We would like to run a theme day where the children will learn more about how the war impacted the lives of children and their families. We will do some cookery, learn about evacuation and complete some WW2 themed crafts. We would love the children to come to school dressed as a WW2 child, although this is optional and normal school uniform should be worn if your child does not wish to dress up. There is no requirement for a special costume to be purchased – trousers/shorts and a shirt, or a dress with cardigan are all appropriate. You could add a brown luggage tag with their name, or a cardboard box to hold an imaginary gas mask.
