Learning Focus:	Our learning focus for this session is on the following areas of the Early Years curriculum - Communication and Language: Understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important. Children will learn new vocabulary, connect one idea or action to another using a range of connectives. Understanding of the World: Children will explore the natural world around them and understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around them. Expressive Art and Design: Create collaboratively, sharing ideas, resources and skills using a range of different materials.

Other Information:	This half term we have been learning about the world around us to help us answer our big question: Look up, look down, what is all around?
